Sherburne County has yard compost sites free of charge in four locations.

All compost sites are gated and locked, and access is only allowed if you have an access card. Access cards are FREE for all Sherburne County residents.

Commercial yard waste companies are required to pay to obtain an access card.

Access cards are available at Becker City Hall, Big Lake City Hall, Elk River City Hall, Zimmerman City Hall.

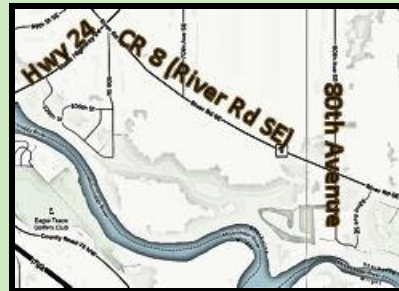
